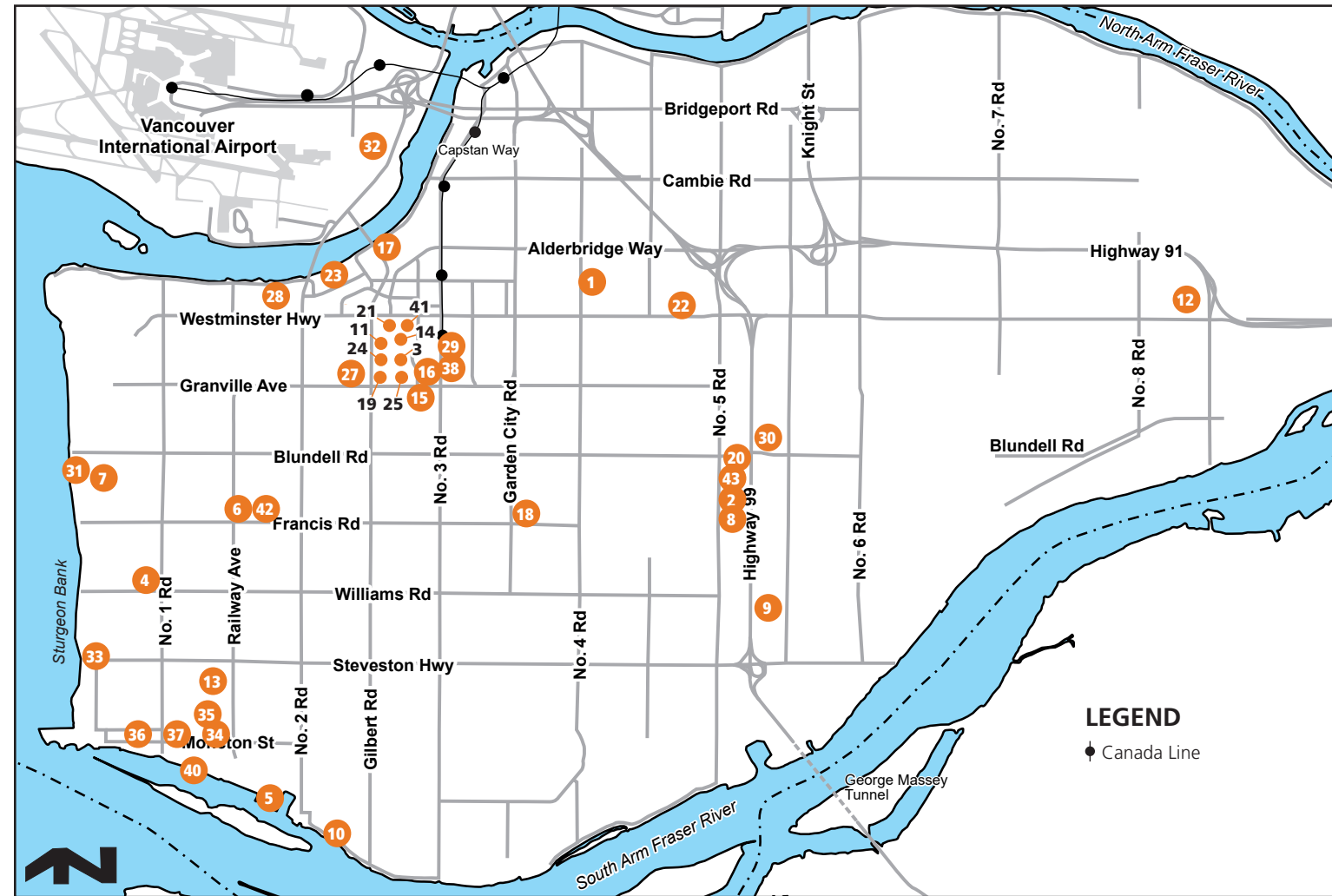

5500 No. 4 Road

Tour this historic temple, first built in 1928. Other activities include Japanese pastry making, Buddhist flower arrangement, and Seiza Meditation sessions.

See Richmond artists Shamsi Ashti work on a sculpture that explores human relationships with shrinking wilderness and Jenifer Gustavsen painting live.

Climb aboard an original Richmond tram and speak with tram restoration volunteers. Kids can restore railway spikes and go on a fun scavenger hunt.
